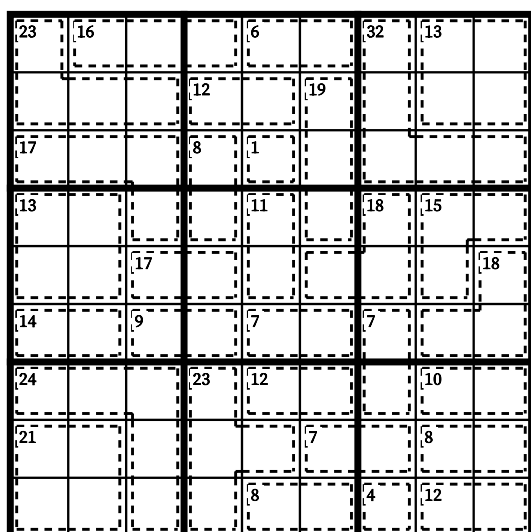


PUZZLE OF THE WEEK

HOW TO PLAY

Every row, every column and every block holds each number once. The grid size sets the numbers: six by six uses 1 to 6, nine by nine uses 1 to 9. A block is the small rectangle marked by the thicker line.

The dotted cages add up. A cage is the group of cells inside one dotted outline, and the small number in its top left corner is what its cells add up to, with no number repeated inside the cage.

Nothing is filled in at the start: the cages are the whole puzzle, and exactly one arrangement fits.

Exactly one solution, found by the program that made this puzzle.

Cut along the line, or use the PNG of the same block. Print at 100 percent, not scaled to fit. Black and white, no grey.
